Drive west as far as you can, taking you to the west-most row of hangers. Ted's P60 hanger faces east. Park on grass anywhere in the vicinity, but please make sure your car does not overhang any hard surface for wing clearance. There is a lot of additional space for parking down the ramp past Ted's hanger to the south.

All our general chapter meetings through September will be held in Ted's hanger. We have obtained enough chairs and serving tables so everyone should be comfortable.

**Chapter Scholarship:** Elton is to receive and review the applications, which are due by 6/28. Information about the scholarship is not yet on the website. Shane brought a sample of the scholarship application, which the board reviewed and commented on. He will create an updated version from comments.

**Young Eagles:** Shane reported that our YE credits will be used for Angel Jaimez to attend an Air Academy session, as requested in March. Nancy Blazyk worked with OSH to get him full credit even though we did not have quite enough Chapter credits. There will be a "dry run" for the 5/21 Rally, to be held on 5/7 at LITH.

**Learn to Fly Day:** Lon brought samples of an advertising flyer. He also indicated there would be some

media coverage. He described the format of the intro material that will be presented, and indicated there would be an opportunity to sign up for a demo flight as well.

**Web Editor:** After some discussion, Shane volunteered to take a look at our website to see if he could take on the updating role.

**May Meeting:** The May meeting, our first to be held at LITH, was discussed. Rob Nelson will be contacted to get food for the event, and if necessary Joe will assist with this. The need for chairs and tables was discussed. There is a table in Bill Rose hangar which Ron will get next week. We will likely ask for members to bring their own chairs. Considerable discussion centered on the format and content of the meeting. Some felt it would be a good opportunity to introduce the chapter to tenants at the airport. Mike cautioned that it was our first meeting at the new location, and it might be better to "get our feet wet" there before opening our doors to guests. Also some suggestions were made regarding possible speakers.
