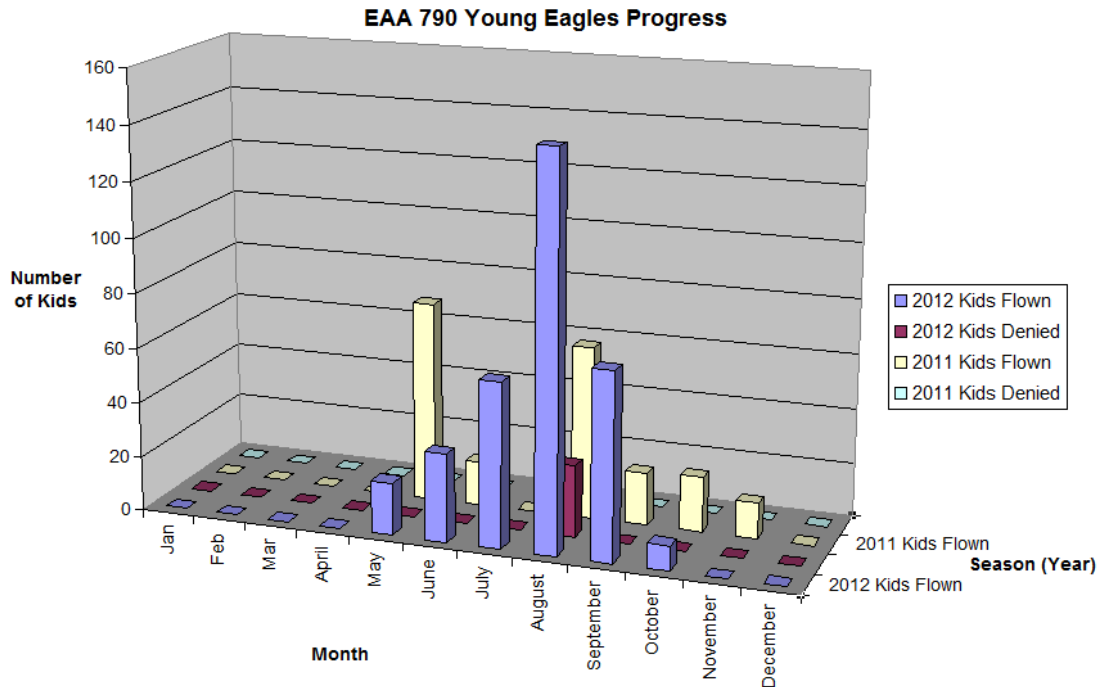

The 2012 Young Eagle season may have ended for Chapter 790, but not in the minds of the kids. We've continued to receive phone calls and email from parents asking if there will be more flights this year (as of October). The efforts made by Chapter 790 members over the past few years have made a tremendous impact on the local population. The Lake in the Hills airport has become a part of their lives.
